Introduction

Regenagri Standard – Farms is an international certification scheme for regenerative agriculture owned by Regenagri CIC (hereinafter referred to in this document as “Regenagri”).

This Appendix defines the Regenagri certification schemes and structure.

How to read and use this document

All provisions using the verbal form “shall” are mandatory requirements for certification and continued certification under the Regenagri Farms certification scheme.

Provisions using “should” are recommendations intended to support effective implementation and performance against the Continuous Improvement (CI) framework.

Provisions using “may” indicate permission, and “can” indicate possibility or capability.

1. Regenagri Certification Schemes

1.1. The Regenagri certification system includes the following certification schemes and standards:

- Regenagri Farm Certification Scheme
- Regenagri Chain of Custody (CoC) Certification Scheme
- Regenagri Carbon scheme

1.2. Regenagri shall maintain and update the publicly available register of certified organisations on the Regenagri website:

2. Certification Structures

2.1. Certification under the Regenagri Standard - Farm shall apply to agriculture production and may be implemented as:

- Individual certification, where a single farm or legal entity is certified;
- Group certification, where a group of farms (smallholders, medium- or large-size farms) is certified under a central management system responsible for ensuring compliance;
- Multi-site certification, where multiple sites operated under a single legal entity or management system are certified.

2.2. Certification under the Regenagri Chain of Custody (CoC) Standard shall apply to all entities handling and processing Regenagri certified materials and may be implemented as (see Regenagri Content Standard and Annex I of Regenagri Standard Farms):

- Individual certification, where a single site or legal entity is certified;
- Group certification, where multiple entities are certified under a central management system responsible for ensuring compliance;
- Multi-site certification, where multiple operational sites are certified under a single organisation.

3. Supply Chain Coverage and certification requirements

- 3.1. The entire supply chain involved in critical activities and handle Regenagri-certified materials shall be covered by valid certification under Regenagri Standard – Farms or Regenagri or Regenagri CoC Standard.
- 3.2. All sales of Regenagri certified materials shall:
 - Be included within the scope of a valid Regenagri Scope Certificate; and
 - Be supported by valid Transaction Certificates, where applicable.
- 3.3. The conditions under which products may be sold as Regenagri certified are specified in Section 2.4 of Regenagri Standard – Farms and Appendix V — Regenagri Traceability and Transaction Certificate Requirements.
